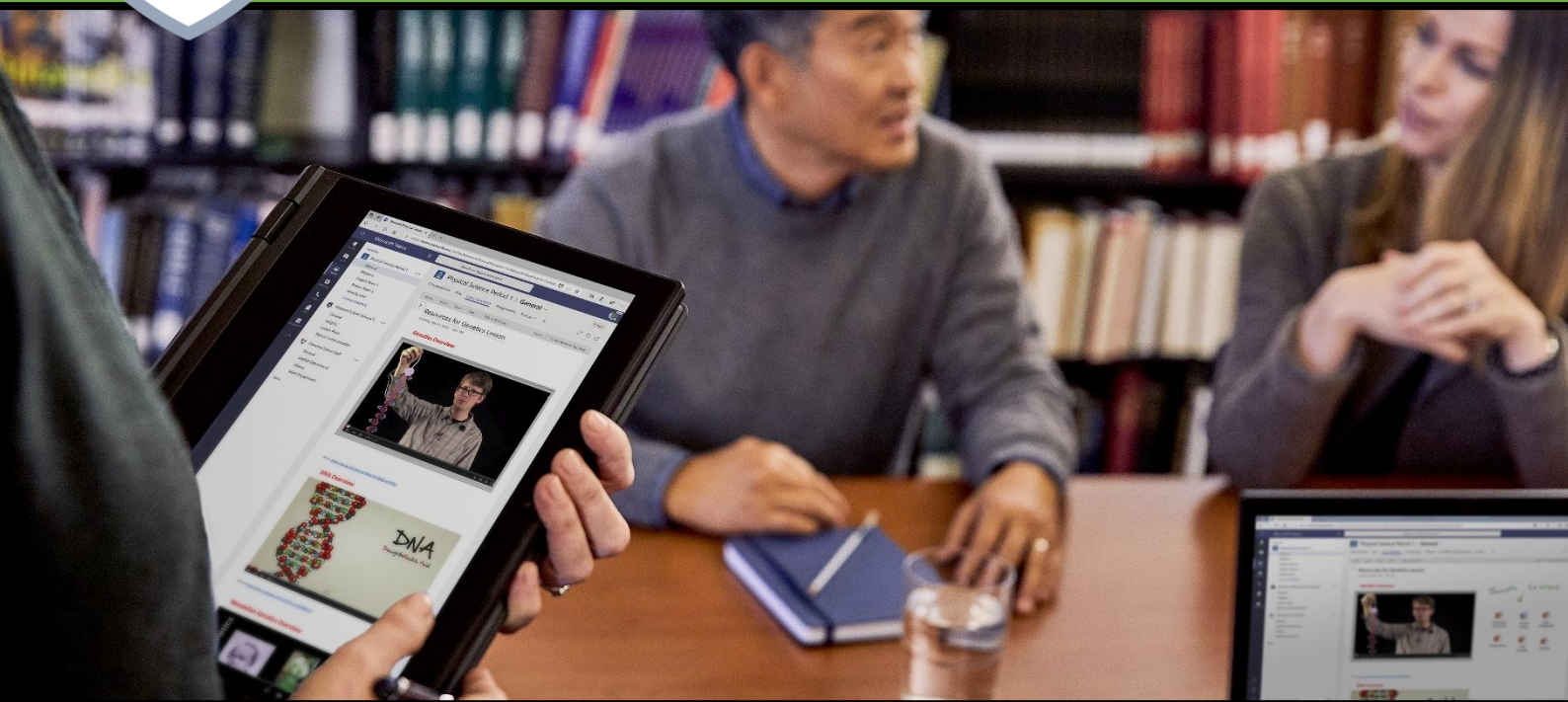




Accessibility and Inclusive Curriculum Design
